

CTI-CFF Implementation Area



TAR Strong legislative, policy and regulatory frameworks in place for achieving an ecosystem approach to fisheries management (EAFM)

- ACT #2 Improve enforcement of IUU fishing through greater collaboration


- ACT #1 Design and launch a region-wide CTI COASTFISH Initiative

- ACT #2 Establish an informal CTI Forum on Tuna Governance



 - D. Information Management and Networking.








Mechanism for Implementation

1. Either party may initiate proposals for activities that would be carried out under current MOU.
2. Specific details for those activities shall be set forth in a Letter of Arrangement that shall include such terms as:
 - Elaboration of the responsibilities of each party
 - Schedule of implementation for the specific activity
 - Budgetary allocations and sources of funds for each activity
 - Any other necessary items for the efficient achievement of the activity
3. Both parties shall be responsible for the evaluation of these activities




