MANAGEMENT TOOL TO REDUCE IUU FISHING

RATIONALES OF RFVR ESTABLISHMENT

- Management tool to reduce IUU fishing
- Enhancing collaboration initiative among AMSs, through the information sharing on fishing vessels data/information
- Providing AMSs with reliable and rapid tools to share information on vessels engaging in “International Fishing Operations”
- A practical tool for related authorities of AMSs elimination of IUU fishing in the region
- Facilitation AMSs to take coordinated countermeasures against IUU fishing

DATABASE SYSTEM SECURITY

1) Access Security

- ✓ User-account (Username and Password)
- ✓ Registration and changeable account and password
- ✓ Use CAPTCHA to avoid hacking by computer program
- ✓ Lock system, after entry 3 times invalid PW

2) RFVR run on web hosting company

- ✓ Use high rank of dedicated server providers

POLICY ON DATA SHARING IN THE RFVR-24M

- 1) AMSs agree in principle to share country fishing vessel record to the SEAFDEC RFVR-24m Database;
- 2) The RFVR-24m database would be shared with all AMSs, but sharing such information to public required approval by the AMS;
- 3) The RFVR database will be updated at least twice a year for effectiveness in combating IUU fishing;
- 4) The user account and password would be provided to all AMSs via the SEAFDEC Council;
- 5) Ensuring security of information, to access the RFVR database system requires user account and password; and
- 6) To enhance the usage of RFVR database, IUU fishing vessels could be shared with other AMSs.

STRENGTHEN COOPERATION AMONG AMSs

- 1) **Sharing** of Fishing Vessel Record by AMSs regularly (annually) to increase the effective RFVR tool in the ASEAN region; and
- 2) **Awareness building** on usage of the RFVR-24m in combating IUU fishing to Relevant Stakeholders *e.g.* fishing boat owner, port authority, etc.
