# 10<sup>th</sup> Marine Protected Areas (MPA) Technical Regional Exchange

&

**Technical Working Group Meeting**

**Venue: CTI Centre Manado, Indonesia** 

#### **Background:**

The Coral Triangle Initiative on Coral Reefs, Fisheries, and Food Security (CTI-CFF) Regional Secretariat (RS), as part of its ongoing implementation of the Regional Plan of Action (RPOA) 2.0 (2020-2030), will host the 10<sup>th</sup> Marine Protected Areas (MPA) Technical Regional Exchange (T-REX) and Technical Working Group (TWG) Meeting from October 7–10, 2024. This Technical Regional Exchange aims to promote the sustainable management of marine biodiversity and fisheries resources in the Coral Triangle region by focusing on strengthening governance, building capacity, and enhancing stakeholder engagement in the MPA sector.

Aligned with the following RPOA 2.0 targets; (A1) Coral Reefs, Mangroves, and Seagrass Beds, (A2) Food Security and Coastal Livelihoods, and (C1) Good Governance, Effective Leadership, and Strategic Partnerships, the CTI-CFF Regional Secretariat, in collaboration with strategic partners including the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) and the World-Wide Fund for Nature (WWF), will conduct a 3.5-day Technical REX. The event will feature various technical sessions covering key topics during Days 1 and 2, such as the status of the Coral Triangle Marine Protected Area System (CTMPAS) framework, an introduction and overview of the IUCN Green List, and the exploration of financial options for supporting MPAs, alongside discussions on upcoming priority activities.

On Day 3, participants will take part in a site visit to the Bunaken MPA, followed by information-sharing sessions on Day 4 focused on the CT Atlas data management. The event will conclude with the MPA TWG Meeting on the afternoon of Day 4.

#### **Objectives:**

- i. Update the current status of the CTMPAS
- ii. Establish priority linkages of the CTPMAS to the IUCN Green List
- iii. Explore the financial options for MPA support in the Coral Triangle Region



- iv. Build capacity on:
  - a. Strengthening the MPA network in the Coral Triangle Region
  - b. Improve handling and management of CT the Atlas Data

- i. Updated list of CTMPAS Nomination Committee and the call for the 3<sup>rd</sup> round of nomination.
- ii. Review and update the CTMPAS framework.
- iii. Identify capacity-building needs for MPA, CTMPAS, and Learning Sites
